Winter Crop Program

Below is a schedule of possible activities that may be carried out in the BettaCrop winter crop program. This is a guide only and the timing and completion of activities will vary depending on seasonal conditions and individual client needs.

Pre season and planning

- Review cropping/pasture rotation,
- Review soil management plan
- Summer fallow inspections & controls as required
- Agworld, online paddock plan and farm map
- Financials for full season inputs
- Crop rotations & seed varietal selection
- Nutrient audit & fertiliser programs (set target yields)
- Herbicide programme & resistance management strategies
- Planting treatment options
- Grower Pre-season meeting

Planting

- Confirm sowing plan and paddock preparation
- Pre emergent herbicide management
- Seed and fertiliser placement at sowing

Crop/pasture Establishment

- Plant establishment assessments, starting crop moisture (WUE)
- Early season weed, insect & disease inspections

Growing Season

- Growing season weed, insect & disease inspections and management
- Crop and pasture biomass assessments Satamap, NDVI.
- Crop and pasture utilisation strategies
- Topdressing recommendations

End of Growing Season

- Windrow/desiccation crop options
- Record escaped weeds, insects & disease issues
- Harvest/seed set and resistance management
- Yield estimates
- Rotation plan for following year

Post Harvest

- Yield data collection and evaluation (data provided by grower)
- Calculate WUE
